

Resolution for the Formation of a Kingston Mission Planning Committee

- WHEREAS** there is a need in the Kingston Mission of the Ottawa Circuit for better organization and oversight; and
- WHEREAS** the Rev. Michael Meleg, who has been the chief organizer of this venture for the past year, cannot physically provide for all the needs of this project of the Circuit by his own resources; and
- WHEREAS** this is to be a mission of the whole Circuit in compliance with Lutheran Church-Canada's (LCC) East District Convention Resolution 1-07, "to create new mission opportunities"; be it
- RESOLVED** that this Circuit strike a Kingston Mission Planning Committee; and be it further
- RESOLVED** that this Committee be comprised of 3 clergy and 3 lay persons of the Circuit elected or appointed by the Circuit in Forum, October 26th, 2002; and be it further
- RESOLVED** that the Committee's responsibility is to include (but not be limited to) the following:
- 1) investigate the needs in order to maintain Word and Sacrament ministry including catechetical instruction in Kingston (i.e. place of worship, investigation of continued funding, demographics, etc.);
 - 2) ensuring this mission is in compliance with LCC polity;
 - 3) regularly reporting to the Circuit through its Forums and Pastoral Winkels on the Mission's status and details of the Committee's work; and be it finally
- RESOLVED** that this Committee function for a period of one year, and its function be reassessed at that time.
