The mystery of the Ascension of Our Lord: Where did Jesus go???

This is how the mystery of the Ascended Lord is resolved in these parts. It normally goes like this:

"Deaconess, I know where Jesus is!"

Where?

"In heaven"

Where's heaven?

"Up there." (Fingers point to the wild blue yonder past contrails, clouds and trees.)

I see, way up past where no one can see or touch or feel any thing, and it's very cold. What did you just confess this morning?

(Face screws up in confusion.)

He ascended...

"to the right hand of the Father."

Where is God?

"Everywhere!"

Where is God's right hand?

"Where God the Father is."

So where is Jesus?

"At God's right hand."

So if God the Father is everywhere, and if Jesus is at God's right hand, then that must mean that Jesus is...

"Everywhere God the Father is!"

And if you have God the Father together with His Son, then the Holy Spirit is there with them, too. So heaven must be.

"Everywhere God the Father, His Son, and the Holy Spirit are."

Now if we are talking about God the Father, His Son, and the Holy Spirit, what sort of language are we speaking?

"Baptism" (Since they have often heard the words of Jesus in Matt 28:19.)

"Like when we make the sign of the cross."

So where does heaven come down to earth in a splash just for you?

"In Baptism!"

And where else does heaven come to you? When the pastor says "Lift up your hearts," watch out! Heaven is going to meet earth! When is that?

[Pause for thinking] **"Oh! I know, just before the part in the liturgy for Communion!**

Heaven comes to earth in Jesus' body and

Blood." (Since they have often heard the words of Jesus repeated in Matt 26:26f, Mark 14:22f, Luke 22:19f, and I Cor 11:23f.)

Right. And where else can you either hear or see heaven on earth?

"When pastor speaks! When he speaks for Jesus."

"When he forgives our sins."

"When he makes the sign of the cross on us."

"When he absolves us, says we are forgiven."

"When he tells us about Jesus."

"In the Word!"
