THE GLORIA PATRI AND ALLELUIA (OR LAUS TIBI)

(From Septuagesima to Holy Saturday, instead of the Alleluia -- Praise be to Thee, O Lord, King of eternal glory.)

THE PSALM ANTIPHON

Have mercy upon me, O Lord, and hear my prayer.

THE PSALM (4)

Answer me when I call, O God of my right! Thou hast given me room when I was in distress. Be gracious to me, and hear my prayer. O men, how long shall my honor suffer shame? How long will you love vain words, and seek after lies? *Selah*. But know that the LORD has set apart the godly for himself; the LORD hears when I call to him. Be angry, but sin not; commune with your

own hearts on your beds, and be silent. *Selah.* Offer right sacrifices, and put your trust in the LORD. There are many who say, "O that we might see some good! Lift up the light of thy countenance upon us, O LORD!" Thou hast put more joy in my heart than they have when their grain and wine abound. O Lord, hear my prayer. And let my cry come to Thee.

THE COLLECT

Visit, we beseech Thee, O Lord, this dwelling, and drive far from it all snares of the enemy; let Thy holy angels dwell herein to preserve us in peace; through our Lord Jesus Christ. *Amen*.

The Lord be with you. *And with Thy spirit.*

Let us bless the Lord. *Thanks be to God.*
